St Anthony's Behaviour Management Process



MAJOR AND MINOR BEHAVIOURS



	Major	Minor
	(Referred/Reported to leadership)	(Teacher Managed)
PHYSICAL CONTACT/ AGGRESSION	 Aggressive fighting (hitting, kicking, punching, tackling) with the intent to cause harm. Physical force as an act of revenge or retaliation. Throwing something at someone in an unsafe or aggressive manner (student has lost control or is throwing large objects such as furniture). Any aggressive physical contact with an adult. 	Mild pushing, shoving or yelling at another student.
INAPPROPRI ATE LANGUAGE	 Sustained or directed aggressive swearing. Swearing of a racial or sexual nature. Sexual or threatening body language toward others. 	 Name calling (self or others) . Accidental use of inappropriate language (non-directive). Rude body language (giving the finger).
DEFIANCE/NON COMPLIANCE/ DISRESPECT	 Repeatedly & deliberately walking away from a staff member. Leaves school grounds without permission. Running away from a staff member/out of the classroom where the safety of the child is at risk, or where a staff member has to leave their class unattended in order to locate or tend to the child. 	 Ignoring teacher's instruction, no attempt to complete work. Not following classroom/school rules. Goes out of bounds at recess or lunch time. Refusing to come to a teacher to discuss an issue or concern. Disobeying instructions, argumentative, questioning authority.
DISRUPTION	Repeated and deliberate interruption of other students' game.	 Walking through other students' game. Talking at inappropriate times in the classroom, masses/liturgies or assemblies. Interrupting classroom learning by calling out or silly, attention seeking behaviour. Throwing small things in the classroom, non-directive (pencil, eraser etc). Yelling and screaming.
BULLYING AND HARASSING	 Repeated verbal, physical or social attacks. Repeated or severe threats. Constant and targeted name calling. Repeated electronic harassment. 	 Minor put downs, one off name calling. Minor conflicts between friends or students of same age. Refusing to play or work with another student.
PROPERTY MISUSE	 Vandalism (toilet paper on ceiling or stuffed in sinks, graffiti etc.). Repeated and aggressive kicking or pushing of bins, bags, lunch boxes. Accessing inappropriate content through school computers (sexual, violent, racial). Online group chats that exclude or disrespect other students or staff. Stealing (major – returning to block and going through bags). 	 Using equipment unsafely or carelessly. Throwing food, littering. Minor inappropriate use of technology (on the wrong site at the wrong time). Stealing (minor).
