

#### **Everything Number**

The Koalas have been absolutely loving everything to do with numbers, so we decided to set up a dedicated number provocation in the classroom and it's been such a hit that it's now into its second week! Number provocations are designed to spark children's natural curiosity and help them develop early numeracy skills through hands-on, play-based learning. These thoughtfully arranged invitations encourage children to explore counting, number recognition, patterns, and problem-solving in fun and meaningful ways. Whether it's sorting natural objects, building towers, or using ten frames, these activities make mathematical concepts visible and engaging. They also provide real-world context, cater to different learning styles, and support children in building confidence with numbers at their own pace all while having fun!

### R U OK Day

Thursday of Week 8 marked R U OK Day across Australia. In the Koala Room, we embraced this as a special opportunity to introduce our preschoolers to the important ideas of kindness, empathy, emotional awareness, and supporting others, all in an ageappropriate and gentle way. We talked about how it's important to check in on people who might look a little sad and explored simple ways we can show care and support. The children shared ideas about what we can say or do when someone isn't feeling their best — from offering a kind word to simply sitting with a friend or giving them a cuddle. We also discussed what we can do to help ourselves when we feel a bit sad. Together, we created a list of helpful mood-changers and calming activities — and then we put them into practice! These included: Blowing bubbles, Dancing, Cooking, Colouring-in, Solving puzzles, and of course, a comforting cuddle! It was a wonderful way for the children to learn that everyone has feelings, and that there are many ways we can support both ourselves and each other. We're so proud of how caring and thoughtful the Koalas were during these conversations and activities.
